### CITIZENS COMMENTS

Cassandra Austin – Wanted to thank the Village for all their support with Summer on State. Just a reminder that the hours for the event are Saturday, June 8 from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

Jacqueline Kowalwski, who lives on 802 Kathi Dr., is concerned that the quality of William Ryan Homes is lacking. A steel beam was put in improperly; not as shown on the floor plan. Her warranty is running out and William Ryan Homes was supposed to come out to make repairs in August 2018 and they have not heard back from the builder yet. She is worried about the repairs to be done and that they will not be completed in a timely manner.

Melissa Seeger of 806 Kathi Dr. has had many issues with William Ryan Homes. Window problems with the flashing and moisture penetration. She has also had mold problems. The attic had issues which she believes to be fixed. She has been asking William Ryan Homes to come and fix the issues with her home. Since she bought this house, she has had nothing but problems. She knows her neighbors also have issues with their home that was built by William Ryan Homes, too. She had reports from B&F showing first an inspection was failed then the following report stating the issue was fixed the same day and time, which she found to be odd.

Keith Seeger of 806 Kathi just wants William Ryan Homes to come and do the job correctly.

We are thinking of doing a video showing the correct way to recycle and the improper way to recycle.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE LIQUOR REGULATIONS TO CHANGE HOURS OF BUSINESS OPERATIONS FOR HOLDERS OF A CLASS B-1 LIQUOR LICENSE IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village has previously adopted various regulations governing the sale of alcoholic liquors in the Village, Hampshire Municipal Code, Chapter 3: Liquor Regulations; and

WHEREAS, among said regulations, the Village prescribes the hours of business operations allowed for each class of license; and

WHEREAS, the Village Liquor Commission has recently had occasion to review said regulations, and has recommended that the hours of operation for the holders of a Class B-1 license be expanded to allow for an earlier opening time, to wit: 8:00 a.m., each day of the week; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that such recommendation for change of hours of operation for holders of a Class B-1 liquor license in the Village ought to be accepted and approved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Hampshire Municipal Code of 1985, as previously amended, shall be and hereby is further amended to provide for a change in the hours of operation for certain licensees, in words and figures as follows:

CHAPTER 3 LIQUOR REGULATIONS

SECTION 3-1-6 CLASSIFICATION OF LICENSES; FEES; CLOSING HOURS

C. Class B-1 License - Package Sales:

^ \* \*

3. Establishments or premises holding a class B-1 liquor license shall close each night at one o'clock (1:00) A.M., except that on Sunday night they shall close at twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight, and shall be closed at the following times each week:

1:00 A.M. through 8:00 A.M. on Sunday 12:01 A.M. through 6:00 A.M. on Monday through Saturday

- Section 2. Any and all ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance, shall be and hereby are, to the extent of any such conflict, superseded and waived.
- Section 3. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, according to law.
