WHEREAS, pursuant to the Subdivision Regulations of the Village, Section 7-2-4(D)(3), a maintenance bond in an amount equal to ten (10%) per cent of the estimated cost of the required improvements is generally required to be held by the Village as a condition of acceptance of said improvements by the Village, for any necessary repairs arising out of the defects in work or materials in said public improvements.

This letter certifies the completion of the public improvements indicated on the attached Certificate of Completion for the above referenced project. AN ORDINANCE ADDING AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND DEPRECIATION TO THE RATES CHARGED FOR USE OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICES IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village has previously established a certain rate to be charged for the use of water in the Village, to wit: \$4.72 per 1,000 gallons of water used, for the first 1,000 gallons, and \$4.72 for every 1,000 gallons used thereafter, Hampshire Municipal Code, Section 8-1-9(A); and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously established a certain rate to be charged for the use of its sewerage system in the Village, to wit: \$5.89 per 1,000 gallons of metered water usage, together with certain surcharges, and subject to the special conditions set forth in the Hampshire Municipal Code, Section 8-1-9(B); and

WHEREAS, there are and will be capital improvements and regular maintenance matters for the Village's water supply and distribution system, and sanitary sewer conveyance and treatment system, which are necessary and advisable for the operation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of the components of the combined waterworks and sewerage system in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village received bond proceeds made available through Kane County under the American Restoration and Rehabilitation Act of 2009 at a favorable rate of interest it was possible to undertake sanitary sewer rehabilitation and storm sewer improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide continued sufficient funds for repayment of the bond utilized to finance the rehabilitation and improvement projects, and for other future expenses in the combined waterworks and sewerage system, the Corporate Authorities deem it necessary and advisable to add to the rate to be charged for the use of water in the Village a surcharge for construction purposes equal to \$10.00 per month, an increase of \$5.00 per month over what is currently charged for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Hampshire Municipal Code of 1985, as previously amended, shall be and hereby is further amended, to provide for a change in the rate to be charged for the use of water in the Village, as follows:

CHAPTER 8

WATER AND SEWER

ARTICLE 1

WATER

SECTION 8-1-9

WATER AND SEWER RATES; BILLING; DELINQUENCY

- C. Capital Improvements and Depreciation Charge:
- Commencing with billing on July 1, 2016, there shall be and is imposed a charge, in addition to the rates otherwise charged for water and/or sewer service, for capital improvements and depreciation in the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the Village, to be assessed on and added to the regular bi-monthly billing statements rendered to users of water and sewer services, in the following amount:
 - a. For users of water and sewer:

\$ 10.00 per month

b. For users of water alone, or of sewer alone: \$ 5.00 per month

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded and waived.

Section 3. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, Section 4. approval and publication as provided by law.

The purpose of a Business Development Commission is to retain current businesses - explore opportunities to develop public / private partnerships that would to attract new commercial and industrial business to the Village - thereby resulting in increasing local sales and real estate tax revenues, creating new employment opportunities, diversifying the local economy along with enhancing the community's image and quality of life.

An additional purpose is to foster a need for a more concentrated effort toward an actual economic development plan and a push from business leaders to eventually have a full time economic development person on the Village staff.

This would be a grassroots effort. The Commission will be comprised of a seven member board. It will consist of one Village Trustee and six members made up of community stake holders, especially those with backgrounds in leadership, marketing, banking, commercial real estate, commercial and industrial development and a desire to help Hampshire grow. Five of the seven members must be Hampshire residents with the sixth and seventh ones possibly being non-residents having a financial tie to the Village.

The members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Village President with the advice and consent of the Village Board of Trustees.

The chairman of the Commission shall be a Village Trustee. The Village President and the Chairman of the Economic Development Committee shall be ex-officio members of the Commission.

The Commission will meet once each month, on a regularly scheduled day and time to be determined. All meetings shall be held in accordance with the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5ILCS 120/*1 et seq.
