COVID-19 Update:

Mr. Hedges reported the drive thru testing facility that was at Hampshire High School tested 238 people. Additionally, anyone can now sign up to be an ambassador to help share information about prevention measures, testing resources, and other relevant information. He will be asking for a comparison of what services WM currently provides to the Village and what additional services they could provide. The Village Services Committee will then meet to discuss what kind of service package the Village might want before considering a bid.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for Fiscal Year 2019-20 were \$1,056,016.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for Fiscal Year 2020-21 are \$1,147,370. This represents an 8.65% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for Fiscal Year 2019-20 were \$0.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for Fiscal Year 2020-21 are \$0.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for Fiscal Year 2019-20 were \$1,056,016.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for Fiscal Year 2020-21 are \$1,147,370. This represents an 8.65% increase over the previous year.

RE:	Annual Tax Levy Ordinance of the Village of Hampshire for 2020 (Collected in 2021)

Background. The 2020 Tax Levy Ordinance is attached for your review. Each year corporate authorities for the Village of Hampshire are required to estimate the revenues required to operate the various functions of the Village. Included in the revenues are those amounts funded through the property tax. Consequently, the Village Board must estimate the amounts required for the property tax levy so that the funds generated through this revenue instrument will become available during the 2021-2022 fiscal year. The Tax Levy Ordinance must be approved by the Village Board and submitted to the County by the last Tuesday in December (29th).

Analysis. The 2020 levy request is \$1,147,370 an increase of 8.65% over the prior year's extension of \$1,056,016. The actual levy extension will be reduced, however, after the County Clerk has applied the property tax extension limitation. In March of 2021, the County Clerk will provide the limiting tax extension and, if the Village's request has exceeded the tax extension limitation, the levy amount will be reduced accordingly. If, on the other hand, the request for the levy extension is underestimated and does not meet the limitation figure, the Village will not have the ability to levy more to make up the difference. Therefore, it is critical that the original request is considerably higher than the actual anticipated levy in order to capture all new growth in the community.

Since the tax levy request shows an increase of greater than 5% when compared to the previous extension, a public hearing is needed to meet the requirements of the Truth-in-Taxation law and will be held at the start of the meeting on Monday. A resolution was approved by the Village Board determining the levy request on November 19th which exceeded the 20 day advance notice requirement to act upon the ordinance and the statutory requirement to public the notice of hearing was published in the Daily Herald on December 18. The Village has met the legal requirements and is free to consider and act on the Tax Levy Ordinance at this time.

Recommendation. Staff recommends approval of the 2020 Tax Levy Ordinance in the amount of \$1,147,370.

THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2020 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2021

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Hampshire, Kane County, Illinois did on the 16th day of April, 2020 pass the Annual Budget Ordinance for the Village for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2020 and ending April 30, 2021, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of ten million, one hundred seventy thousand, eight hundred fifty-five dollars (\$10,170,855) which said Budget Ordinance was duly published in pamphlet form on April 20, 2020 and a certified copy thereof filed with the County Clerk of Kane County, Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Hampshire, Illinois, subject to taxation for fiscal year 2021, the sum of one million, one hundred forty-seven thousand, three hundred seventy dollars and zero cents (\$1,147,370.00) for the following specific purposes designated in said Budget Ordinance and in the respective sums as follows:

RE:	Ordinances for Levy and Assessment of Taxes in 2020 for collection in 2021 in and for the Village of Hampshire Special Service Areas No. 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12 and 15.

Background. Several subdivisions or business parks within the Village of Hampshire have Special Service Areas designed to generate sufficient funds to maintain certain improvements specific to the given subdivision or special service area (SSA). The originating ordinance for each maintenance SSA may specify the maximum amount that can be levied to generate these funds. Each year, the Village must determine the cost to provide this special maintenance service and levy a tax against the properties in the SSA.

Analysis. Staff is bringing forward 9 ordinances setting the amount of the levy for 9 of the active 11 maintenance SSAs. The Village Board must levy the amounts specified in the ordinances against the properties in the SSA to be able to fund the services provided to the areas. Typically the special services provided are drainage related, but they also may include landscape maintenance such as mowing and weed control. The actual levy amounts are to accommodate the costs incurred in maintaining the applicable area.

Special Service Areas do not have the same notification requirement as the Village's corporate levy as long as the levy amount is not greater than 5% greater than the prior year extension.

Rather, the Village must assure that amount levied is less than the maximum amount included in the establishing ordinance.

Staff continues to work to establish an appropriate maintenance schedule for each of the SSAs. The attached document shows the projected levy and maintenance schedule for each of the active SSAs.

Further comment will be provided in a presentation on the levy for the maintenance SSAs.

Recommendation. Staff recommends approving the Levies for SSAs 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12 and 15 by ordinances that follow.

RE:	Police Pension – Municipal Compliance Report

Background. When the population of the Village reached 5,000 the Village was required to establish a Police Pension Fund run by a separate board comprised of active police, retired police and appointed individuals. The official 2010 census pushed the Village of Hampshire over the mark and the Village of Hampshire Police Pension Fund was established on May 1, 2012. House Bill 5088 requires that Police Pension boards are required to issue an annual report on the financial condition of the fund to the Village. This report, called the Municipal Compliance Report, is to be provided to the Village board before the tax levy is filed on or before the last Tuesday in December (or Wednesday this year due to the holiday).

Analysis. The Village of Hampshire does not levy a property tax for the purpose of financing the pension fund at the present time as no new levy line items can be implemented without the successful passage of a referendum by the electorate of the Village. The Village's annual contribution to the Police Pension fund is taken from "discretionary funds" within the General Fund. Public Act 096-1495 requires that the taxes collected, deductions from the salaries or wages of police officers and revenues from other sources are equal to the normal cost of the pension fund for the year plus an amount sufficient to bring the total assets of the pension fund up to 90% of the total actuarial liabilities of the pension fund by the end of the municipal fiscal year 2040. Each year the Pension Fund engages an enrolled actuary to update the assumptions, census and determine this requirement. The Municipal Compliance Reports is then completed each year by the Pension Fund and is provided to the Village. This year the report reflects that the fund was 34.65% funded (down from 51.93% last year) and has levy requirement of \$647,752 (up from \$295,328 last year). The Illinois Department of Insurance's Public Pension Division will also, independently, compute the funded ratio and estimated levy requirement. There numbers are 38% funded with a funding requirement of \$526, 819. On January 24, 2020 Pubic Act 101-0627 went into effect. This legislative change reclassified 9 members of the Hampshire Police Pension Fund from Tier 2 to Tier 1. This change results in an increase in contribution of approximately \$297,500.

Recommendation. Staff recommends acceptance of the 2020 Municipal Compliance Report, and while the Village does not levy for Police Pension at the present time, staff further recommends that the levy requirement proposed in the Municipal Compliance Report be used in preparing the FY22 budget.
