## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE'S LIQUOR REGULATIONS TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE IN THE B-2 LICENSE CATEGORY IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village has adopted regulations governing the types and characteristics of various classifications of licenses allowing for the retail sale of alcoholic beverages and package goods in the Village; and

WHEREAS, included in said regulations is a limitation in number for each of the various classifications of license available in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received an application for a new B-2 category liquor license for package sales at a convenience store, to be located at the new Speedway gasoline station and convenience store; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commission has reviewed the application and has considered the creation of a new license in the B-2 category, and recommends creation of the license for issuance to said applicant; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it advisable to create one additional license in the B-2 license classification at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Hampshire Municipal Code of 1985, as previously amended, shall be and hereby is further amended to create one new license in the B-2 Liquor License Classification, in words and figures as follows:

CHAPTER 3 LIQUOR REGULATIONS

ARTICLE I ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR REGULATIONS

Section 3. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.

RE: Request for Release of Impact Fees Collected and Interest Earned on

Account

Background. Contact was recently made with Huntley Fire, Huntley School District and Huntley Library indicating that the final impact and transition fees from Lakewood subdivision had been received and reconciled. Subsequent to that contact, the Village received requests from the Huntley Fire Protection District and Huntley School District for the release of all collected fees and interest earned on the accounts. We now have the request of the Huntley Area Public Library.

Analysis. The balances have been verified and are the final amounts due from new development within the Huntley library district calculated. The funds for this distribution will be used to fund the purchase of books for the library's collection.

**Recommendation.** Staff recommends the release of \$5,943.99 from the Huntley Area Public Library's impact, transition and interest fee account. The balance is comprised of \$3.097.76 in impact fees and \$2,846.23 in interest. All transition fees were previously distributed to the library.

Background. The Village of Hampshire is one of more than 2,200 local and state government agencies in Illinois that voluntarily participates in the Illinois Funds, a local government investment pool (LGIP) operated the Illinois State Treasurer's Office which was created in 1975. The Village receives distributions of state administered funds such as income, sales, telecom and motor fuel tax funds via direct deposit/investment. In the past most property tax distributions were directed to Illinois Funds as well. Last summer we were notified that Illinois Funds was required to comply with a Rule 2a-7 of the Securities and Exchange Commission which had recently changed. This change made it impossible to continue offering traditional bank services. We essentially now have an investment account rather than an interest earning checking account. The biggest change, however, was that all "deposits" had to come from either the Village itself or the State in the form of investments and no third party transactions are allowed including transactions from the county or federal government.

Analysis. The Village, with thoughts of depository diversification, has opened an account at Resource Bank. This will be a government funds interest bearing checking account which is earning .23338% at the present time. Fund will be transferred by check as needed from this account to the Village's First American operating or accounts payable account. The first county real estate deposit is expected Wednesday, May 18, 2016.

**Recommendation.** Staff requests affirmation of initiation of a government funds account at Resource Bank for the purpose of handling receipt of Kane County Property Taxes: Hampshire Taxing District 064, Hampshire SSA #16 District 614, and Hampshire SSA #19 District 617.

RE: Purchase Squad Cars

**Background.** The FY17 operating budget included funds to acquire two new squad cars for the Police Department via three-year financing. The state contract price for a 2016 police-packaged Dodge Charger came in at \$22,500 per unit.

Analysis. Staff is recommending entering into a three loan for the purchase of these vehicles. The loans will include the purchase price the cost of equipment and supplies and striping plus a documentation fee, if required, for a total outlay of approximately \$53,000 plus interest. Financing will be finalized once the cars are ordered and delivery is estimated.

**Recommendation.** Staff requests authorization to purchase two 2016 Dodge Chargers from Fenzel Motors for the state contract amount of \$22,500 plus expend approximately \$3,925 additional for equipment, installation and striping per squad.

## AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE WATER AND SEWER BILLING RATES IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village has previously adopted certain regulations for its billing rates for providing water services in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that in order to continue providing such service, together with the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the water distribution system in the Village it is necessary and advisable to increase the rate charged to users of the service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPSHIRE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Hampshire Municipal Code of 1985, as previously amended, shall be and is hereby further amended to provide for certain rates for the use of water in the Village, in words and figures as follows:

CHAPTER 8 WATER AND SEWER

ARTICLE 1 WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS

SECTION 8-1-9 WATER AND SEWER RATES; BILLING;

DELINQUENCY

A. Water Rates, Bi-Monthly, And In-Bulk:

1. Rates Established:

For each 1,000 gallons \$ 4.72 per thousand gallons

For water to be sold in bulk quantities, for uses which will not result in discharge to the village's wastewater conveyance and treatment system.

\$ 14.16 per thousand gallons.

Water rates shall be adjusted July 1<sup>st</sup> annually based on the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index – All Urban Consumers for the Chicago-Gary-Kenosha area. This adjustment shall be automatic unless the Village Board takes official action to waive the adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index or determines the adjustment shall be based on a different factor.

- B. Sewer Rates
- 5. Sewer User Service Charge:
- a. The sewer user service charge to be paid bi-monthly by all metered sewer users shall be a minimum charge of one dollar (\$1.00) for billing plus a basic user rate of five dollars and eighty-nine cents (\$5.89) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water usage.

Sewer user service charge rates shall be adjusted July 1<sup>st</sup> annually based on the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index – All Urban Consumers for the Chicago-Gary-Kenosha area. This adjustment shall be automatic unless the Village Board takes official action to waive the adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index or determines the adjustment shall be based on a different factor.

b. The sewer user service charge by all nonmetered residential or commercial sewer users shall be one dollar (\$1.00) minimum for billing plus a basic user charge of fifty three dollars and one cent (\$53.01) per month which allows a maximum wastewater discharge of nine thousand (9,000) gallons per month. The debt service charge as calculated in subsection B4 of this section shall be added to the bill. Whenever it has been determined by the village that the nonmetered wastewater discharge exceeds nine thousand (9,000) gallons per month, the village may require such nonmetered sewer user to install metering devices on the water supply or building sewer to measure the volume of wastewater discharged to the public sewer (Ord. 09-14, 5-7-2009).

Section 2. The new rates established by this Ordinance shall take effect with the July 2016 billing.

Section 3. Any and all ordinances, resolutions, and orders, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of any such conflict, are hereby superseded and waived,

Section 4. If any section, subdivision, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance,

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
