 - Discussion of local regulation and taxation of adult-use cannabis / planning for January 1, 2020 legalization of adult-use cannabis in Illinois, with Village Attorney Mark Schuster; and recommendation(s) to Board of Trustees.
 - i. Broader scope of concerns that need to be addressed:
 - 1. In addition to B2 Zoning District, Highway Commercial Zoning District might be a viable place for retail dispensary.
 - 2. Police Chief Thompson is open to having business in truck stop area, in regard to policing of cannabis business.
 - ii. The committee is opposed to having a cannabis retail business that allows using the product on site.
 - iii. It is recommended by the committee to require a cannabis business to acquire a special use permit.
 - 1. This would allow Village more oversight of the retail establishment.
 - iv. All cannabis business types (Craft Grower, Cultivation, Infusion, Processing, and Transporting) and acceptable zoning locations were discussed and a petition to

recommend for approval to the Village Board will be presented to the Village Board.

- v. A Zoning Board of Appeals meeting will need to be held on Tuesday, December 10 for a public hearing.
- vi. Particulars of ordinances were discussed for the purpose of further clarification.
- vii. Tax needs to be uniform for all types of businesses. The Village Board will need to decide the tax rate.
